# BARN DO'S

- **MUST WEAR A FACE MASK**
- **SOCIAL DISTANCE**
- **MUST SIGN IN AND OUT WITH THE QR CODE**
- **Feed your animal twice a day**
- **Clean up after your animal in common areas** (poops when animal is walking around by showers, scales, hallways, by arena etc)
- **Clean pen on regular basis**
- **Pick up your trash**
- **Dump shavings/manure into the back of the dumpster** (push toward the parking lot) if shavings fall on ground or beside dumpster clean it up too
- **Be responsible**

# **BARN DON'TS**

- **BRING PEOPLE TO THE BARN WITH YOU**
- **Forget to feed**
- **Leave poop in common areas**
- **Leave wheelbarrows full of manure and not in right place**
- **Leave equipment/ boots in aisle**
- **Leave belongings at the barn**
- **Go in another person's pen**
- **Feed or mess with another person's animal**
- **Hang out in the parking lot**
- **Allow animals in the restroom**
- **Hang unsecure bucket from the pens**
- **PARK IN THE FIRE LANE!**

# Dumpsters

ONLY manure and old feed should go in the long, rectangular (manure) dumpsters that are on the north side (front) of the barn.

Feed sacks, shavings bags, wood, or anything other than BIODEGRADABLE material MUST go in the tall trash dumpster on the south (back) of the barn.

DO NOT put shavings bags or feed sacks in the small trash cans around the barn!

When dumping wheelbarrow of manure in the dumpster, you should go as far in the dumpster as you can with the wheelbarrow and dump or shovel the manure as high as you can.





# CONSEQUENCES

3 strikes you're out!

- **1<sup>st</sup> offense** – Written warning by an Agricultural Science teacher and parent notification
- **2<sup>nd</sup> offense** – Written warning by the Agricultural Science teacher which will be passed on to the administrator of the campus which the student attends. They will meet with student and one legal guardian,
- **3<sup>rd</sup> offense** – Removal of animal from facility
- **We do not want the district to shut us down for not following proper COVID procedures.**

# Large Animal SELECTION

- Saturday, September 19th
- Lamb and goat exhibitors, bring halters!
- Pig exhibitors, leave the pig whips at home!
- Take a picture of your tag number
- Understand that if the school district shuts down prior to this date, we will have to implement the Alternative Selection Process listed after the Modified Selection process below.
- We Must social distance while there and wear a mask



# SELECTION

## Entering the facility and Parking

- The exhibitor and one additional person may enter the show barn (located at THS)
- PLEASE DO NOT ENTER PRIOR TO YOUR START TIME
- Lamb exhibitors:
  - Park near the old practice baseball fields/by ROTC and walk to the northeast corner of the show barn and enter through those doors/roll up doors.



# SELECTION

## Entering the facility and Parking

- Pig exhibitors:
  - NO TRAILER may park in the Early Excellence Academy Parking lot OR the field across the street from THS at the corner of Quinn Rd. and Baker.
  - Those WITH TRAILERS MUST park in the field across from the show barn.
  - Walk through Early Excellence Academy parking lot and enter through the south roll up door of the show barn (behind the greenhouse).
- Goat exhibitors:
  - NO TRAILER may park in the Early Excellence Academy Parking lot OR the field across the street from THS at the corner of Quinn Rd. and Baker.
  - Those WITH TRAILERS MUST park in the field.
  - walk through Early Excellence Academy parking lot and enter through the 3 doors on the more northern side of the show barn.

# Schedule for SELECTION

- **Set 1 - Selection Numbers 1-25**

- 7:00 AM - Doors will open for #1-25
- 7:00 - 7:30 AM - viewing of the species
  - (must stay in designated area of the show barn)
- 7:30 AM - Start the actual selection with number 1.
  - Each exhibitor will have 3 minutes to choose the animal.
  - Warning times will be given at 1 minute and 30 seconds.
  - If the exhibitor has not chosen when those 3 minutes is up, the teachers will move to the next exhibitor in the selection order.
  - Each exhibitor will continue to select in chronological order then remove their animal if going home or put it in a designated area for the barn then exit the building.
- 8:45 AM - all exhibitors should be done and have left the building

# Schedule for SELECTION

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- **Set 2 - Selection Number 26-50**
  - 9:00 AM - Doors will open for #26-50
  - 9:00 - 9:30 AM - viewing of the species
    - (must stay in designated area of the show barn)
  - 9:30 AM - Start the actual selection with number 26.
    - Each exhibitor will have 3 minutes to choose the animal.
    - Warning times will be given at 1 minute and 30 seconds.
    - If the exhibitor has not chosen when those 3 minutes is up, the teachers will move to the next exhibitor in the selection order.
    - Each exhibitor will continue to select in chronological order then remove their animal if going home or put it in a designated area for the barn then exit the building.
  - 10:45 AM - all exhibitors should be done and have left the building

# Schedule for SELECTION

- **Set 3 - Selection Number 51-75**

- 11:00 AM - Doors will open for #51-75
- 11:00 - 11:30 AM - viewing of the species
  - (must stay in designated area of the show barn)
- 11:30 AM - Start the actual selection with number 51.
  - Each exhibitor will have 3 minutes to choose the animal.
  - Warning times will be given at 1 minute and 30 seconds.
  - If the exhibitor has not chosen when those 3 minutes is up, the teachers will move to the next exhibitor in the selection order.
  - Each exhibitor will continue to select in chronological order then remove their animal if going home or put it in a designated area for the barn then exit the building.
- 12:45 AM - all exhibitors should be done and have left the building

# SELECTION

## Transportation on your own

- If you are transporting your own animal, after you have selected your animal, you are required to load your animal and leave the facility immediately.
- While at the project and show barn remember to social distance and wear a face covering.
- The gates will be open at the barn for you to unload where you need to.



# SELECTION

## Transportation to the Project Barn

- After you have selected your animal, you are required to leave the facility immediately.
- This will be done at the conclusion of each species.
- We will start with lambs
- For each load to the barn we will send a remind on the TMHS AG BARN remind to let you know what tag numbers are on the trailer so you know when to go to the project barn.

- While at the project and show barn remember to social distance and wear a face covering.
